ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT OF ASSOCIATION OF THE SOUTHWEST MISSOURI AMATEUR RADIO CLUB AND COPY ISSUED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned officers of the Southwest Missouri AMATEUR RADIO CLUB, in connection with others, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Missouri, relating to benevolent, religious, scientific, educational and miscellaneous associations under Title 23, Chapter 352, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, 1949, have entered into the following agreement of association:

## ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be Southwest Missouri Amateur Radio Club.

## ARTICLE TWO

The principal place of the corporation shall be in the City of Springfield, Greene County, Missouri.

## ART ICLE THREE

The corporation shall have perpetual duration, is not formed for profit, and shall have no capital stock.

### ARTICLE FOUR

The purposes and scope of this corporation are as follows:

1. To provide for scientific study and advancement in the field of amateur radio communication, to promote science, information and skill among amateur, or "ham", radio operators, and to promote and provide for some good in the order of benevolence that is useful to the public.

2. To provide a supply and source of skilled, trained, capable and efficient radio operators, together with necessary equipment to be used at any time, day or night, for emergency communicato civilian authorities, tion service to civil defense, to the military,/to peace officers, Red Cross, and private industry and to establish, organize and maintain a standing and ever-ready organization of committees and special assignments that may be instantly called into service in the event of an emergency, disaster, or catastrophe.

3. To educate and inform the general public of the usefulness, availability and purpose of the services of amateur radio operations.

4. To educate and train and to give practical experience in amateur radio operations to young people and boys and girls individually and as members of youth organizations, the members of this organization, and others.

5. To hold public field day exercises and demonstrations, of amateur radio communications services and to make test and trial runs of emergency organization and equipment.

6. To hold meetings and gatherings of its members, in order to exchange knowledge, information and ideas; to discuss mutual problems; and to hear addresses, lectures and papers on amateur radio operations and services; and, to promote good fellowship and understanding among its members.

7. To join and work with other amateur radio operators, groups, associations and corporations in carrying out the above purposes.

## ARTICLE FIVE

The corporation, for the purposes and scope heretofore set out, shall have the power and authority to acquire, purchase, hold, lease, rent, sublease, exchange, mortgage, sell, or otherwise convey or deal in and with both real and personal property owned and desired to be acquired by this corporation. The corporation shall have the power to construct improvements and buildings upon such real estate. The corporation shall have the power to borrow money, issue notes, bonds, debentures, or other obligations of the corporation, to secure the payment of the same by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other instrument in writing. The corporation shall have the power to receive gifts, legacies and donations, of any source whatsoever, to make gifts and appropriations from any and all of its funds or assets from time to time to carry out the objects and purposes of the corporation, and to exercise any and all power and authority as may be necessary to carry out the objects and purposes of the corporation not in conflict with the Constitution and laws of the United States or the Constitution and laws of the

State of Missouri, and to have all powers provided for such a corporation under the statutes and laws of the State of Missouri made and provided.

## ARTICLE SIX

The corporation shall have the power to adopt by-laws for the government of the corporation and its members. The corporation shall be managed and controlled by such officers and directors and such number of persons as may be prescribed by the by-laws. The by-laws may provide that less than a majority of the officers and directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. ARTICLE SEVEN

These articles may be amended by the affirmative vote of twothirds of the members present at any meeting of the members, notice of the proposed amendment having been given in the call of the meeting, or by a three-fourths affirmative vote of the entire board of directors at any meeting. Such amendment shall become effective in the manner provided by statute.
